WHEREAS, there is a need to use the services of the local police in conjunction with the FY2024 Ocean County Prosecutor's Program (formerly known as the Fatal Accident Support Team, F.A.S.T.) as set forth in the attached Schedule "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Plumsted is able provide these services and will be paid at a rate of \$55 per hour by the County, with a minimum of four hours per callout.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Plumsted, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Shared Services Agreement between the Township of Plumsted and the County of Ocean for the FY2024 Ocean County Prosecutor's Program (formerly known as the Fatal Accident Support Team, F.A.S.T.), as set forth in the attached Schedule "A".
2. That this Agreement shall be retroactive from January 1, 2024, and shall continue in full force and effect until December 31, 2024.
3. That the police officers will be paid at a rate of \$55 per hour by the County, with a minimum of four hours per callout.
4. That a copy of this Agreement will be on file with the Township Clerk's Office.
5. That certified copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Plumsted Township Police Department; the Plumsted Township Finance Office and the Ocean County Prosecutor.

SCHEDULE A
SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT
PROSECUTOR'S PROGRAM

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____ 2024, by and **BETWEEN:**
THE Township of Plumsted, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, having its offices located at **121 Evergreen Rd., Plumsted, New Jersey 08533** , hereinafter referred to as "Municipality". **AND: THE COUNTY OF OCEAN**, a body politic of the State of New Jersey, having its offices at the Administration Building, 101 Hooper Avenue, P.O. Box 2191, Toms River, New Jersey, 08754, hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, resolution of the **Township of Plumsted**, dated _____ authorization was given to enter into an Shared Services Agreement with the County of Ocean Police services, **Prosecutor's Program** and

WHEREAS, the **Prosecutor's Program** is a traffic safety program (formerly known as the Fatal Accident Support Team, F.A.S.T.) By the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office (hereinafter referred to as "Prosecutor's Program") for the purpose of assisting in the investigation, prosecution of fatal accidents and in traffic enforcement and education; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Program receives funding from the County of Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office and the Municipality have determined it to be in their mutual interest for the Municipality to designate certain police officers to be assigned to Prosecutor's Program; and

WHEREAS, the shared Services Act, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq., authorizes local units as defined in the Act to enter into joint agreements for the provision of governmental services; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to enter into an Agreement with the County for the purpose of setting forth the terms and conditions regarding the assignment of police officers employed by the Municipality to the Prosecutor's Program

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth pursuant to the authority provided by law, the parties hereby agree to and with each other as follows:

1. **DESIGNATION OF POLICE OFFICERS FOR ASSIGNMENT TO PROSECUTOR'S PROGRAM.** Upon request by the County, the Municipality shall designate those officers to be assigned to the **PROSECUTOR'S PROGRAM** and shall provide the County with a list of those officers.

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

PROSECUTOR'S PROGRAM

2. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF MUNICIPALITY.** The Municipality agrees that it shall have the following responsibilities during the term of this Agreement:
 - (a) The Municipality will provide department in-service training to those officers assigned to the Prosecutor's Program.
 - (b) The Municipality will be responsible for conducting weapons qualifications for those officers assigned to the Prosecutor's Program.
3. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF COUNTY.** The County agrees that it shall have the following responsibilities during the term of this Agreement.
 - (a) The County will forward to the Municipality a schedule of any training attended by or instructed by the officers assigned to the Prosecutor's Program.
 - (b) The County shall provide the Municipal Police Department with information on current Prosecutor's Program activities within the Municipality during scheduled briefings.
4. **COMPENSATION.** The County shall pay the officers department at the rate of fifty- five (\$55.00) per hour for their performed hereunder, with a minimum of four hours per callout. Upon exceeding four hours officers will be compensated for each additional hour worked at the aforementioned rate. It is the responsibility of the individual officer's department to pay any income tax or other taxes required to be paid from their salary received pursuant to this agreement.
5. **TERM.** This Agreement shall be retroactive from January 1, 2024 and shall continue in full force and effect until December 31, 2024.
6. **TERMINATION.** Either party to this Agreement may, be giving written notice to the other party, terminate this Agreement.
7. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** The officers assigned to the Prosecutor's Office pursuant to this Agreement are not and shall not be considered agents or employees of the County.
8. **VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT.** During the time of their assignment to the Prosecutor's Office, the officers shall continue to be governed by the rules and regulations of the Municipal Police Department.

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

PROSECUTOR'S PROGRAM

In the event of any violation of the said rules and regulations, the officer committing the violation may be returned to the Municipal Police Department for appropriate disciplinary action.

9. **VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE.** The Prosecutor's Office shall assume responsibility for the actions of the officers during the period of their service in the Prosecutor's Program and shall handle disciplinary action for the violation of the rules and regulations of the Prosecutor's Office. In its discretion, the Prosecutor's Office shall investigate any alleged violations of its rules and regulations and violations of public trust. The Prosecutor's Office shall file a written report of any alleged violations with the Chief of Police of the Municipal Police Department, along with a report of the investigation, any conclusions reached and subsequent disciplinary action, if any.
10. **ASSIGNABILITY.** The Municipality shall not assign or transfer any of the work or services to be performed hereunder of any other interest in this Agreement without the prior written approval of the County.
11. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT,** This Agreement contains the entire Agreement between the parties and no modification hereof shall be effective unless in writing, signed by the party to be charged therewith. This Agreement shall supersede any other understanding or correspondence that may have been exchanged between the parties on the subject matter hereof.
12. **BINDING EFFECT.** This Agreement has been duly entered into and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the County and the Municipality, enforceable in accordance with its terms, and it shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their successors and assigns.



SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, 2024, by and BETWEEN: **THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED TOWNSHIP**, having its offices located at **121 EVERGREEN ROAD, NEW EGYPT, N.J. 08533** hereinafter referred to as "Municipality".

AND: THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, having its offices at Administration Building, **101 HOOPER AVENUE, TOMS RIVER, NEW JERSEY 08754**, hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, by resolution of the Township Committee of PLUMSTED, dated _____, authorization was given to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the County of Ocean for the FY24 Traffic Enforcement Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant is run by the Ocean County Sheriff's Office (hereinafter referred to as "Sheriff's Office") in an effort to improve the safety of motorists and pedestrians on our county's roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Enforcement Grant Program receives funding from the State of New Jersey and the County of Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office and the Municipality have determined it to be in their mutual interest for the Municipality to designate Police Officers to be assigned to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes local units as defined in the Act to enter into joint agreements for the provision of governmental services; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to enter into an Agreement with the County for the purpose of setting forth the terms and conditions regarding the assignment of Police Officers employed by the Municipality to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth pursuant to the authority provided by law, the parties hereby agree to and with each other as follows:

- 1) **DESIGNATION OF POLICE OFFICERS FOR ASSIGNMENT TO THE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT.** Upon request by the County, the Municipality shall designate Police Officers to be assigned to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant detail.
- 2) **RESPONSIBILITIES OF MUNICIPALITY.** The Municipality agrees that it shall have the following responsibilities during the term of this Agreement:
 - a. The Municipality will be responsible for assigning Police Officers to conduct high visibility traffic enforcement along County Route 528 & 539.
 - b. The Municipality will be responsible for submitting reimbursement requests to the Sheriff's Office for overtime expenses for services performed by assigned officers as follows:
 - (October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024) due September 1, 2024
- 3) **RESPONSIBILITIES OF COUNTY.** The County agrees that it shall have the following responsibilities during the term of this Agreement:
 - a. The County will forward to the Municipality a schedule of dates and times to conduct the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant events.
- 4) **COMPENSATION.** The County shall reimburse the Municipality for overtime expenses incurred by Police Officers in their department assigned to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant for services performed hereunder. The hourly rate of overtime reimbursement shall not exceed seventy dollars (\$70.00) per hour; until designated grant funding for overtime reimbursement has been exhausted. Compensation of overtime hours shall not exceed the hours of the scheduled event as defined in Section 3a. The Traffic Safety Officer's department will pay any income tax or other taxes required to be paid from each Officer's salary received pursuant to this Agreement.
- 5) **TERM.** This Agreement shall be retroactive from October 1, 2023 and shall continue in full force and effect until September 30, 2024.
- 6) **TERMINATION.** Either party to this Agreement may, by giving written notice to the other party, terminate this Agreement.

- 7) **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** The Police Officers assigned to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant pursuant to this Agreement are not and shall not be considered agents or employees of the County.
- 8) **VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT POLICE OFFICER.** During the time of their assignment to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant, the Police Officer shall continue to be governed by the rules and regulations of their respective Municipal Police Department. In the event of any violation of the rules and regulations, the Police Officer committing the violation may be returned to the Municipal Police Department for appropriate disciplinary action.
- 9) **VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF SHERIFF'S OFFICE.** The Sheriff's Office shall assume responsibility for the actions of their Sheriff's Officer(s) assigned to the Traffic Enforcement Program Grant and shall handle disciplinary action for the violation of the rules and regulations of the Sheriff's Office. In its discretion, the Sheriff's Office shall investigate any alleged violations of its rules and regulations and violations of public trust. The Sheriff's Office shall file a written report of any alleged violations with the Chief of Police of the Municipal Police Department along with a report of the investigation, any conclusions reached and subsequent disciplinary action, if any.
- 10) **ASSIGNABILITY.** The Municipality shall not assign or transfer any of the work or services to be performed hereunder of any other interest in this Agreement without the prior written approval of the County.
- 11) **ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement contains the entire Agreement between the parties, and no modification hereof shall be effective unless in writing, signed by the party to be charged herewith. This Agreement shall supersede any other understanding or correspondence that may have been exchanged between the parties on the subject matter hereof.
- 12) **BINDING EFFECT.** This Agreement has been duly entered into and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the County and the Municipality, enforceable in accordance with its terms, and it shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their successors and assigns.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP FOR THE USE OF THEIR FIREARMS RANGE FACILITY AND PROPERTY

PARTIES:

The parties to this Agreement are Manchester Township, Manchester, NJ, and Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Ocean County Police Academy, New Jersey Transit, New Jersey State Police, U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, Borough of Bay Head, Amtrak, Lakewood, Point Pleasant Borough, Point Pleasant Beach, Plumsted, Borough of Mantoloking, Borough of Seaside Park, Toms River, Barnegat, and Metuchen (Outside Agencies).

PURPOSE:

To enter into an agreement where Manchester Township will allow the above Outside Agencies to access and use the Manchester Township Firearms Range facility and property for training, competition or other approved purposes.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Manchester Township agrees to allow the above Outside Agencies to utilize the Manchester Township Firearms Range facility and property for training and other authorized purposes.
2. The Outside Agencies must have range time pre-approved by the Manchester Township Police Range Master for scheduling purposes.
3. Outside Agencies must have a certified range instructor on site at all times.
4. Outside Agencies must maintain proper insurance coverage for range activities.
5. Outside Agencies agree to accept responsibility for and to release Manchester Township and its personnel, agents or assigns from any and all claims, liabilities, demands or actions of every kind and nature, whether in law or equity, for any loss, damage or injury, to all personnel or property arising from the use of Manchester Township's Firearms Facility by the Outside Agencies, when such claims, liabilities, demands or actions arise from the actions or conduct of the Outside Agency.
6. Outside Agencies are responsible for cleaning up the range and surrounding areas at the completion of their usage. (See Attached Schedule A) Outside Agencies shall be

responsible for any damage done to the range and surrounding areas due to their use of same. Outside Agencies must report any and all damage done to the range facility and property to the Manchester Township Range Master. Failure to report damage done by Outside Agencies can result in suspension of this Agreement.

7. A fee of \$100.00 per day shall be paid for the use of Manchester Township's Firearms Range facility and property. The Outside Agency shall be billed on a semi-annual basis by Manchester Township.
8. The Outside Agency acknowledges that the rate is competitive with competing Local Firearms range facilities.
9. The Outside Agency agrees annually to review the rate in good faith to determine if an increase is appropriate to maintain pricing aligned with local government competition.
10. The Outside Agency shall provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance listing Manchester Township as the Certificate Holder. They shall provide the following coverage:
 1. General Liability: \$250,000
 2. Automobile Liability \$250,000
 3. Excess Liability \$4,750,000
 4. Workers' Compensation and Employers Liability \$2,000,000
11. This Agreement shall remain in effect for 3 years from date of endorsement.

- A certified Firearms Instructor must be present on the range at all times during firearms training/qualifications.
- The range flag and gate key must be signed out and returned to the Manchester Township Police Headquarters.
- Two forms of communications (police radio and cellular phone) and a first aid kit must be present on the range at all times.

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT
DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT CALLOUT PROGRAM

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, by and **BETWEEN: THE Township of Plumsted**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, having its offices located at **121 Evergreen Rd. Plumsted, N.J. 08533**, hereinafter referred to as "Municipality". **AND: THE COUNTY OF OCEAN**, a body politic of the State of New Jersey, having its offices at The Administration Building, 101 Hooper Avenue, P.O. Box 2191, Toms River, New Jersey, 08754, Hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, resolution of the **Township of Plumsted** dated _____, authorization was given to enter into an Shared Services Agreement with the County of Ocean Police services, **Drug Recognition Expert Callout Program** and

WHEREAS, the **Drug Recognition Expert Callout Program** (hereinafter referred to as **D.R.E.C.P.**) is a traffic safety program run by the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office (hereinafter referred to as "Prosecutor's Office") for the purpose of utilizing a DRE callout Program to assist with identifying and removing Intoxicated drivers from the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the **D.R.E.C.P.** receives funding from the State of New Jersey and County of Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the shared Services Act, N.J.S.A. 401:8A-1 et seq., authorizes local units as defined in the Act to enter into a joint agreements for the provision of governmental services; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to enter into an Agreement with the County for the purpose of setting forth the term and conditions regarding the assignment of police officers employed by the Municipality to the **D.R.E.C.P.**; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth pursuant to the authority provided by law, the parties hereby agree to and with each as follows:

1. **DESIGNATION OF POLICE OFFICERS FOR ASSIGNMENT TO D.R.E.C.P.** Upon request by the County, the Municipality shall designate those qualified DRE officers to be assigned to the **D.R.E.C.P.** and shall provided the County with a list of those officers.

2. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF MUNICIPALITY.** The Municipality agrees that it shall have the following responsibilities during the term of this Agreement:
 - (a) The Municipality will provide department in-service training to those officers assigned to the **D.R.E.C.P.**
 - (b) The Municipality will be responsible for conducting weapons qualification for those officers assigned to the **D.R.E.C.P.**
3. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF COUNTY.** The County agrees that it shall have the following responsibilities during the term of this Agreement.
 - (a) The County will forward to the Municipality a schedule of any training attended by or instructed by the officers assigned to the **D.R.E.C.P.**
 - (b) The County shall provide the Municipal Police Department with information on current **D.R.E.C.P.** activities within the Municipality during scheduled briefings or callouts to other municipalities.
4. **COMPENSATION.** The County shall pay the officer's Municipality at the rate of seventy (\$70.00) per hour for their performance hereunder. It is the responsibility of the individual officer's Municipality to pay any income tax or other taxes required to be paid from their salary received pursuant to this agreement.
5. **TERM.** This agreement shall be retroactive from October 1, 2023 and shall continue in full force and effect until September 30, 2024.
6. **TERMINATION.** Either party to this Agreement may, by giving written notice to the other party, terminate this Agreement.
7. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** The officers assigned to the Prosecutor's Office pursuant to this Agreement are not and shall not be considered agents or employees of the County.
8. **VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT.** During the time of their assignment to the Prosecutor's Office, the officers shall continue to be governed by the rule and regulations of the Municipal Police Department. In the event of any violation of the rules and regulations, the officer committing the violation may be returned to the Municipal Police Department for appropriate disciplinary action.

9. VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE.

The Prosecutor's Office shall assume responsibility for the actions of the officers during the period of their service in the **D.R.E.C.P.** and shall handle disciplinary action for the violation of the rules and regulations of the Prosecutor's Office. In its discretion, the Prosecutor's Office shall investigate any alleged violations of its rules and regulations and violations of public trust. The Prosecutor's Office shall file a written report of any alleged violations with the Chief of Police of the Municipal Police Department, along with a report of the investigation, any conclusions reached and subsequent disciplinary action, if any.

10. ASSIGNABILITY. The Municipality shall not assign or transfer any of the work or services to be preformed hereunder of any other interest in this Agreement without the prior written approval of the County.

11. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement contains the entire Agreement between the parties and no modifications hereof shall be effective unless in writing, signed by the party to be charged therewith. This Agreement shall supersede any other understanding or correspondence that may have been exchanged between the parties on the subject matter hereof.

12. BINDING EFFECT. This Agreement has been duly entered into and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the County and the Municipality, enforceable in accordance with its terms, and it shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their successors and assigns.

THIS AGREEMENT made this day of , 202 ,
between the COUNTY OF OCEAN, a body politic of the State of New Jersey, having its principal office and place of business at the Ocean County Administration Building, 101 Hooper Avenue, Toms River, New Jersey 08754, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and the **Township of Plumsted**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, having its principal office and place of business at 121 Evergreen Road, New Egypt, New Jersey, 08533, hereinafter referred to as the "Township".

WHEREAS, the conditions at the intersection of County Road #14 (Monmouth Road/Route 537) & County Road #61 (Hawkin Road)/Emley's Hill Road in the Township of Plumsted (PLSD-4) in the County of Ocean, necessitate the installation of a Traffic Signal in order to improve safety and to expedite the safe movement of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the County has to construct and maintain said Traffic Signal at the aforesaid intersection:

WHEREAS, the **Ocean County Board of Commissioners and Township of Plumsted** executed an electrical agreement for the traffic signal at the intersection of County Road #14 (Monmouth Road/Route 537) & County Road #61 (Hawkin Road)/Emley's Hill Road in the Township of Plumsted (PLSD-4); and

WHEREAS, the agreement should be amended to provide for the modification of a battery backup system and generator bypass accommodations.

NOW, WITNESSETH, that the parties hereto, in consideration of mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the Township and the County agree as follows:

1. The Township shall provide through the utility company for the necessary electric current.
2. The Township will pay for all electric current and battery replacement to be used in the operation of said Traffic Signal.
3. The Traffic Signal shall be maintained, modified and reconstructed by the County of Ocean or others without expense to the Township, except such expenses as are mutually agreed upon and defined in other separate Schedule 'C' agreements between the County and the Township.

4. The Township shall supply the generators and required fuel to be used to power County owned traffic signals. The Township shall refuel the generators for the duration of operation. The generators shall meet or exceed the specification provided by the County to the Township.

5. The Township shall request the County to switching the traffic signal power supply to the Township supplied generator. Prior to the usage of the Township generator, County personnel shall inspect the signal to ensure the signal is operating according to plans and timing directives. The County personnel shall connect the generator to the traffic signal and confirm the signal operation.

6. Once the power has been restored, the Township shall notify the County. County personnel shall disconnect the generator from the controller and switch the power supply and confirm the signal operation.

7. Township agrees to provide, at its own expense and upon forty-eight (48) hours notice by the County to the Township Clerk, uniformed officers to direct traffic during installations, inspections or repairs related to the traffic signal system. The Township further agrees to provide, at its own expense, uniformed officers to direct traffic during emergency repairs, on telephone notice to the Township Clerk. The Township agrees to make every effort to provide uniformed officers within the required time frames and agrees to pay for such services when provided. Should the response time of the uniformed officers be delayed, the Township will immediately advise the County of such. By acceptance of this Agreement, the Township also agrees that this Agreement shall apply to all existing and future signals, operated and maintained by the County, that are within the Township.

8. The County reserves the right to rescind this agreement in giving to the Township in six months' notice in writing of its intention to rescind, which notice shall be served upon the Chairman of the Township Council/Committee of the said Township.

This agreement shall be executed in duplicate. One copy shall be furnished to either party hereto and either copy shall be of equal import and legality.
