DO NOT BRING ASBESTOS CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS ELECTRONICS EXPLOSIVES (INCLUDES BOAT FLARES) INFECTIOUS WASTE ("RED BAG" WASTE) **MEDICATIONS NEEDLES/ SYRINGES OXYGEN TANKS RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS**

SMOKE DETECTORS UNKNOWN/UNIDENTIFIABLE CHEMICALS

ALL MATERIALS (WITH EXCEPTION OF OIL AND GASOLINE) SHOULD BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS.

Limit 200 LBS dry materials & 20 gallons liquid Per household.

No containers larger than 5 gallons.

Proof of residency required: driver's license or tax bill.
