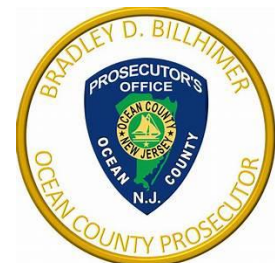
Fostering communication with the community by sharing worthwhile information with residents, as well as identifying happenings throughout Plumsted Township and vicinity.
