Old Business:

<u>Telfeian/Roeder- Ground Mount Solar Variance</u> Block 43, Lot 8.01

This application was carried from the September 6^{th} meeting. Proper noticing in the approved paper has been completed on time for this meeting.

Mr. Arthur Telfeian and Victoria Roeder, the applicants, were sworn in to testify. Mr. Mallon read his review letter on a ground mounted solar system consisting of 1200 sq. ft. of solar panels. Mr. Telfeian stated the panels would be 30-40 feet off the property line. The trees that will be cleared are mostly dead or dying and the trees along the property lines will be cleaned up as well. A natural screen of hemlocks will be placed by the array. The applicants agree to grade and seed within 6 months if the solar panels are taken out of service. No comments from the board or public were made. A motion to accept the application with compliance with the Township

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Engineer's letter was made by Mr. Dancer, seconded by Mayor Trotta. A roll call vote of all in favor by those in attendance.
