**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION I OF
SALARY ORDINANCE 2009-17
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Plumsted, County of Ocean,
State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. Salary Ordinance 2009-17 of the Township of Plumsted, Section I, is hereby amended
and supplemented to provide as follows:
